ENGLISH	HEBREW WORD	PRONOUNCE	MEANING
Feast of Trumpets	Yom Teruah	yohm teh-roo-AH	Day of the trumpet blast or day of shouting; the biblical name associated with the Feast of Trumpets.
Trumpet Blast	Teruah	teh-roo-AH	A loud shout, trumpet blast, alarm, or joyful sound.
Sukkot	Sukkot	soo-KOHT	Booths or temporary shelters; the Feast of Tabernacles.
Feast / Appointed Time	Moed	moh-EHD	An appointed time or meeting set by God.
Awe / Reverence	Yirah	yee-RAH	Reverence, holy fear, or deep awe toward God.
Rejoice	Samach	sah-MAHKH	To rejoice, be glad, or celebrate with joy.
Days of Awe	Yamim Nora'im	yah-MEEM no-rah-EEM	"Days of Awe" - a season of reflection, repentance, and preparing the heart before God.
