REDEMPTION

Ge'ulah

HOW TO PRONOUNCE: geh-oo-LAH

Meaning: Redemption, deliverance, rescue, or being bought back.

A beautiful word for God rescuing and redeeming His people.

Study connection: redemption and deliverance

STOP / CEASE

Shavat

HOW TO PRONOUNCE: shah-VAHT

Meaning: To stop, cease, or rest from work.

This word helps express the idea of stopping from labor and entering rest.

Study connection: Genesis 2:2

THOUSAND / MILLENNIAL

Elef

HOW TO PRONOUNCE: EH-lef

Meaning: One thousand.

"Millennial" is not the Hebrew word. Elef means "thousand" and connects well with a study of the 1,000-year reign.

Study connection: Revelation 20:1-6

RAIN

Geshem

HOW TO PRONOUNCE: GEH-shem

Meaning: Rain; water that falls from the heavens.

In Scripture, rain can remind us of God's provision, blessing, and care.

Study connection: Zechariah 10:1

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
