

WAJD JUNIORS CRAFT

POPSICLE STICK SUKKAH

A Feast of Tabernacles craft for juniors



"Ye shall dwell in booths seven days." - Leviticus 23:42

SUPPLIES

- 16-20 wooden craft sticks
- Washable paint or markers
- Cardstock or construction paper
- Child-safe scissors
- School glue or tacky glue
- Yarn or pipe cleaners
- Stickers, crayons, leaves, or paper fruit
- Small cardboard base (optional)

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Color the craft sticks. Let them dry before building.
- 2 Place four sticks upright as corner posts. Glue them to a small cardboard base if you want extra support.
- 3 Glue sticks across the tops and sides to connect the four posts. Leave the front open for a doorway.
- 4 Glue several sticks across the top for the roof. Leave small spaces between the roof sticks.
- 5 Cut paper panels for the back and side walls. Glue them inside the frame.
- 6 Wrap the posts with yarn or pipe cleaners. Decorate with leaves, fruit, stickers, or drawings.
- 7 Let the glue dry completely, then display your sukkah and remember how the LORD cared for His people.

Adult supervision is recommended for cutting and gluing.
