NEPAL GLACIER DISASTER SCIENTISTS POINT TO EXTREME WARMTH

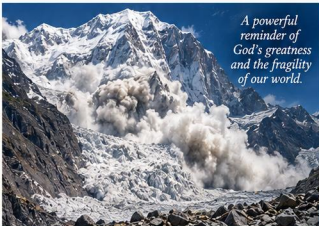
Scientists say climate change likely helped trigger the August 26, 2026 collapse and catastrophic flood in the Nepal-Tibet region.

WHAT HAPPENED

- On August 26, 2026, a high-altitude mass of glacier ice and rock collapsed near the Nepal-Tibet border, triggering a catastrophic flash flood.
- As of September 16-17, 2026, around 1,400 people had been confirmed dead in Nepal and Tibet.
- Roughly 5,200 people remain missing in Nepal, with many feared to be lost.
- Entire villages were swept away, bridges destroyed, and vital infrastructure damaged.
- Figures may change as recovery efforts continue.



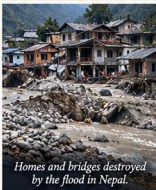

WHAT SCIENTISTS FOUND

- Researchers from World Weather Attribution reported that mean August temperatures in the Himalayan region were about 5°C (9°F) above normal, with around 1.5°C (2.7°F) of that excess warming attributed to human-caused climate change.
- Long-term glacier thinning and thawing permafrost likely weakened the mountain and glacier system, making it more unstable.
- Satellite images before the collapse showed accelerating movement of the glacier-rock mass, according to Nature reporting.
- The precise sequence of how and why the failure occurred is still being studied.

WHY IT MATTERS

- The Himalayan region is becoming increasingly unstable as glaciers melt and permafrost thaws.
- Such collapses can trigger deadly downstream floods, affecting communities far beyond the initial site.
- Critical infrastructure, including hydropower facilities, can be severely damaged.
- This disaster highlights the need for continued monitoring, early warning systems, and preparedness in high-mountain regions.
- It also reminds us to care for God's creation and to be ready, as we live in a changing world.
