## Court update

Finland's Supreme Court upheld Päivi Räsänen's acquittal on the 2019 Bible-verse tweet, but issued a conviction connected to a separate 2004 church pamphlet. The decision has raised serious free-speech and religious-liberty concerns among Christians and legal observers.

The center of the concern is not only one court case. It is the larger question facing believers: when biblical convictions are unpopular, will the written Word of God still be allowed to be spoken clearly, faithfully, and without fear?

## Why WAJD is watching

1. The case shows the growing pressure around public Bible speech. A message can be judged by modern culture even when the speaker is quoting, explaining, or defending Scripture.
2. It reminds believers to speak truth with a clean heart. We are called to avoid hatred, mocking, and cruelty while refusing to compromise the Word of God.
3. It calls the church to discernment. The question is not whether the world approves, but whether we remain faithful to Christ.
