SANDY FIRE FORCES EVACUATIONS NEAR SIMI VALLEY

A WAJD News wildfire update prepared to help readers understand the situation with clarity, prayer, and truth.

What happened?

The Sandy Fire broke out near Simi Valley, California, and spread quickly through dry brush as strong winds pushed flames toward nearby neighborhoods. Fire crews responded from the ground and air while residents in threatened zones were told to evacuate or prepare to leave.

SANTA ROSA ISLAND FIRE GROWS INTO CALIFORNIA'S BIGGEST WILDFIRE

What happened?

A wildfire on Santa Rosa Island in Channel Islands National Park has burned thousands of acres and quickly became California's largest wildfire of the year. Crews faced difficult conditions as the fire spread across dry island terrain and threatened rare habitat.

Officials said the fire was believed to have started after distress flares were used during a rescue involving a stranded sailor. Historic structures, rare plants, and wildlife areas have been placed at risk as firefighters work to slow the spread.

DEADLY PLANE CRASH SPARKS WILDFIRE NEAR RUIDOSO
