

PROPHECY PROVES GOD

*How fulfilled prophecy reveals the truth of Scripture

1. PROPHECY REVEALS GOD'S SOVEREIGNTY

From Genesis to Revelation, the Bible is filled with prophetic declarations that span centuries, nations, and kings. No human author could have written the Scriptures with such precision and consistency while events were still in the future. Prophecy reveals the hand of God working behind history. It proves that He is not a distant observer but the Sovereign Lord who directs nations, raises up leaders, and fulfills His promises with perfect accuracy.

2. GOD DECLARES THE END FROM THE BEGINNING

The Lord does not guess what will happen—He declares it long before events take place. God reveals them to His prophets. Centuries before Israel became a nation again, God said He would gather His people back to their land (Ezekiel 36:24). Centuries before the Messiah walked the earth, God foretold His birth, life, suffering, death, and resurrection in stunning detail (Isaiah 53, Psalm 22). When God speaks, it is certain.

3. FULFILLED PROPHECY BUILDS FAITH

Every fulfilled prophecy is a witness that the Bible is true. Archaeological discoveries, historical records, and current events continue to confirm God's Word. When we read prophecies that were fulfilled in the past, it should embolden our faith for those still to come. If God was faithful then, He will be faithful now. Prophecy is not meant to create fear, but to strengthen our trust in the goodness and power of God.

4. WHY PROPHECY STILL MATTERS TODAY

We live in a time when confusion, deception, and lawlessness are increasing. Prophecy calls us to be watchful, to live holy lives, and to rejoice in the hope we have in Him. It reminds us that history is moving toward the return of Jesus Christ and the establishment of His Kingdom. Prophecy speaks hope in a hopeless world, and it anchors our hearts in the unshakable character of our faithful God.

THE SIGN OF HIS COMING

What Jesus said would mark the last days—and how believers should respond.



1. JESUS TOLD US TO WATCH (Matthew 24:42, Luke 21)

Jesus told His disciples plainly that no one knows the exact day or hour of His return—only the Father. But He did give us signs so we would not be caught off guard. He urged us to “watch” like a faithful servant, staying alert and ready. Watchfulness is not fear; it is spiritual awareness and obedience. The world grows noisy and distracted, but believers must keep their eyes on the Lord. Jesus is coming, and we are called to live as those who expect Him.



2. WARS, RUMORS, AND GLOBAL UPHEAVAL (Matthew 24:6-7)

Jesus warned that in the last days there would be wars and rumors of wars. We see this playing out across the globe—nations rising against nations, tensions escalating, and peace becoming fragile. These are not random events; they are part of the pattern He revealed. Do not be alarmed—be aware. These things must happen, but they do not yet mean the end. Instead, let them drive us to prayer, compassion, and a deeper dependence on God.



3. EARTHQUAKES, FAMINES, AND PESTILENCES

Jesus said there would be earthquakes, famines, and pestilences in various places. These are what He called “the beginning of birth pains” (Matthew 24:8). Birth pains are real and increase in intensity, but they are not the birth itself. They announce that something greater is coming. The world system is groaning under the weight of sin and rebellion. Let us respond with mercy, help the hurting, and point people to the only hope that never fails—Jesus Christ.



4. ISRAEL AND THE PROPHETIC CLOCK

Israel’s rebirth as a nation in 1948 was a stunning fulfillment of prophecy. The land, the people, and above all, Jerusalem remain central in God’s plan. Jesus said Jerusalem would be a “burdensome stone” to the nations (Zechariah 12:3). What we see today confirms that God’s prophetic clock is not broken. It is keeping perfect time. Stand with Israel, pray for the peace of Jerusalem, and remember—God is faithful to every word He has spoken.



5. FALSE TEACHING AND DECEPTION

Paul warned that in the last days people would turn from the truth and follow deceiving spirits (2 Timothy 3–4). False teachers twist Scripture, promote smooth messages, and lead many astray. Even genuine believers can be shaken if they do not know the Word. Discernment is not being negative; it is being spiritually mature. Test everything by Scripture, hold fast to sound doctrine, and cling to Christ. The enemy comes to steal, kill, and destroy—be vigilant.



6. HOPE, NOT FEAR

Biblical prophecy is not meant to paralyze us—it is meant to prepare us. We are not destined for God’s wrath, but for His eternal kingdom (1 Thessalonians 5:9). The return of Jesus is our blessed hope. He will come with power and glory, judge righteously, and establish righteousness on earth. Until that day, we live in hope, sharing the Gospel and reflecting the love of Christ. Our future is secure in Him.



7. HOW BELIEVERS SHOULD RESPOND

Watch—keep your eyes on Jesus and the signs of the times. Pray—intercede for nations, leaders, Israel, and the lost. Live holy—walk in purity, love, and obedience. Preach the Gospel—take the Good News to every person you meet. Serve with joy—be the hands and feet of Jesus. Do not grow weary in well-doing. The Lord is coming back for a people who are awake, faithful, and on fire.

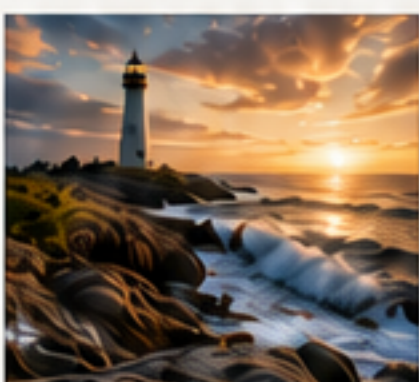
3 A CALL TO HOLINESS

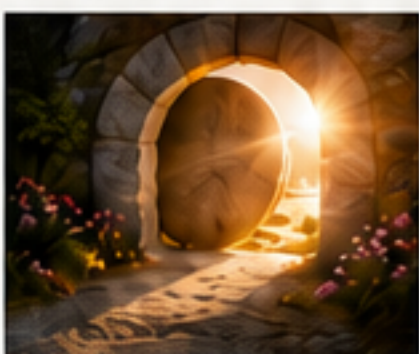
4 STRENGTHEN YOUR FAITH
