Pre & Post Care Guidelines

Medical Contraindications

Please consult your esthetician if you have any of the following conditions:

- Cancer
- Sunburn or open wounds
- Pregnancy / Breastfeeding
- Eczema
- Dermatitis
- Allergy to resorcinol derivatives
- Accutane / Isotretinoin use within the past 6 months

Skin Prep

• Fitzpatrick 3–6 clients not using a tyrosinase inhibitor (See list below) should pick up a product from us 2 weeks prior (Pop-In Appointment via GlossGenius)

For the KRX LASER PEEL: Stop the use of ALL Actives (See list below) and Prescription Retinoids (Tretinoin/Retin-A) at least 7 days prior.

For the KRX MELAPRO PEEL: Stop the use of Prescription Retinoids (Tretinoin/Retin-A) 7 days prior, and all other Actives (See list below) 72 hours prior.

Post Procedure Care

You will be given a FREE Post-Procedure Kit to take home with you.

For the first 24 hours:

- No sun exposure
- No sweating
- Makeup only if necessary (mineral or non-comedogenic)

After 24 hours:

- Please wait 72 hours before using Actives (see list below)
- Please wait 7 days before using Prescription Retinoids.
- Waxing: 2 weeks after peel
- Botox / Fillers: Safe immediately
- Laser Treatments: Ask your technician; we recommend waiting at least 4 weeks

Things to Note

- Appointment time: 30 minutes
- Normal activities can be resumed immediately
- Light flaking may begin around day 3 keep skin hydrated

Next Appointment:

- KRX LASER PEEL: 3-4 Weeks (Series of 6 is recommended)
- KRX MELAPRO: 1-2 weeks (Series of 6 is recommended)

- Over-the-counter Retinol/Retinal (Retinoids)
- AHA/BHA (Alpha Hydroxy and Beta Hydroxy Acids)
 - Glycolic Acid
 - · Lactic Acid
