

NC Center for Safer Schools Required Student Safety Videos

Dear Bear Grass Charter School Families,

As part of our continued commitment to student safety and well-being, students in **grades 6–12** will view age-appropriate safety videos provided by the North Carolina Center for Safer Schools on **Friday, August 21st**. These videos are designed to help students recognize and understand warning signs of adult misconduct, including grooming behaviors, and to encourage students to seek help and report concerns to a trusted adult.

In accordance with Session Law 2023-128/HB 142 and North Carolina General Statute G.S. 115C-105.57(2a), public schools are required to show these educational videos annually. The goal is to increase awareness among students, staff, and families about potentially harmful behaviors by adults and to support a culture of safety, trust, and open communication.

While the videos depict scenarios involving school staff, the message is not specific to school employees. The purpose is to help students recognize concerning behaviors and remain vigilant in all settings and with any adult they may encounter—not just at school.

Parents and guardians may preview the videos through the North Carolina Center for Safer Schools by scanning the QR code or visiting the link on this document.
