Classes divided by sex, Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Best Of Breed. Awards: Ribbons 1st through 4th, Rosettes and Awards for BJH, RJH, BOBP, BOSP, BOBV, BOSV, AWD, ARWD, AWB, ARWB, ABOB, ABOS, ABOW, WD, RWD, WB, RWB, BOB, BOS, BOW.

ALTERED & INTACT PREMIERS WILL BE OFFERED BASED ON 10% OF THE CATALOG ENTRY AND WILL BE AWARDED AT THE SOLE DISCRETION OF EACH OFFICIATING JUDGE (WITH A MINIMUM OF 10 AND A MAXIMUM OF 20)

ENTRY FEES

Pre-Entries will be taken August 1, 2019 and will close September 30, 2019. Regular Classes \$30.00, Non-Regular Classes \$25.00, Junior Showmanship \$10.00 (entries postmarked prior to the opening date or after closing date will be returned)

Day Before Pre-Show Entries Regular Classes \$40.00, Non-Regular Classes \$35.00, Junior Showmanship \$15.00 Entries will only be accepted for classes that have not met the judge's limit and will be taken on a first-come, first-served basis.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- No entries can or will be accepted for a dog, handler or owner disqualified or not in good standing with ASCA.
- Please use a separate entry form for conformation and juniors.

- No entry fees will be refunded. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There is a \$40.00 service charge for any returned checks for insufficient funds or otherwise.
- This is the first pre-show and is held on a condensed schedule as directed by the Nationals Host Club. Therefore, we are required to start judging Best Of Breed Intact Dog Groups prior to the completion of the Intact Class judging.
- Show schedule and armbands may be picked up November 1st from 5:00 PM – 7:00 PM in the Exhibition Hall.
- Age of all dogs will be calculated as of November 2, 2019.
- Exhibitors should be ringside for all classes, ready to be called in. It is the Judge's discretion to allow an exhibitor to enter the ring late.
- Limited, temporary ring-side crating will be available, but NO grooming will be allowed in the Exhibition Hall.
- Any handler, owner, or spectator being abusive towards a dog or exhibiting poor sportsmanship will be asked to leave the show site for the duration of the show.
- Delta ASF, its officers, members and volunteers assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs, personal property, and/or children. Children are to be supervised at all times.
- Rings will be inside a climate controlled building. Surface will be mats on concrete.
