OASA requires that all exhibitors /owners/handlers must pick up after your dog(s).

ASCA requires:

All shows will be held under the current rules and regulations of ASCA. No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA.

OASA requires:

All dogs must be on a leash or confined to a crate or ex-pen at all times, except during competition.

Dogs must be leashed to and from the parking area, to the trial ring, and obedience building.

All dogs must be current on rabies vaccinations, and proof must be available for inspection by the trial committee.

Any owners not in compliance with these regulations will be asked to leave the grounds. No refund of any event fees will be given.
