Entry Limits	Entries are limited to 400 runs a day per judge. Trial entries will close whenever the limit is reached. In the event entries fill, Priority will be given to the first 30 volunteers working two classes per day.		
Opening and Closing dates	Opening: Entries will be accepted with postmarks dated <i>no earlier</i> than Monday, June 3, 2019 . Closing: Entries <i>received</i> by 6:00 p.m. Wednesday, September 4, 2019 , or when entry limits are reached. After this time entries may not be accepted or cancelled. Secondary closing for advancement in level only: Wednesday, October 30, 2019.

CONFIRMATIONS including information regarding classes you have entered will be emailed to all entrants who have provided a valid email. PLEASE READ YOUR CONFIRMATIONS!! General information will be mailed to all entered about a week before the trial and will include site information, check-in time, walk-through/start times and tentative class running orders.

CLASS CHANGES: Moveups must be submitted in writing (email ok) and must be received by the Trial Secretary before **5:00 PM, Wednesday, October 30, 2019.**

Moveups will NOT be allowed at the trial site from the PASA Pre-trial to the Sunday. Pre-Trial. This is because there are no move-ups allowed for the Nationals Trial.

AWARDS: PASA offers rosettes for first through eighth place in each class for each jump height division. 20+” and 24” dogs will be scored together. Ribbons in the ASCA color of green will be offered to every dog obtaining a qualifying score. Dogs that complete an ATCH receive a large rosette and a decorated pole for signing.

HIGH IN TRIAL AWARDS will be awarded as per Section 2.6.2 ASCA Agility rules to the highest scoring dog(s) in the following categories (7 awards in all) Novice, Open and Elite levels (Standard division, dogs must have all runs at the same level), HIT overall in the Junior and Veteran Dog Divisions. Overall in the ACE Divisions, Overall Rescue dog. Fastest combined YPS in the regular classes is the tie-breaker, followed by most gamblers points. Awards include a large rosette and a prize. To be considered for the **rescue HIT you must check the rescue box** on the entry form.

Special Equipment Notes: See Notice to Exhibitors below.

NO SMOKING is allowed within 100' of any trial facility. That includes rings, score table, raffle area, warm up jumps, rest rooms and crating areas. Repeating violators will be asked to leave the premises and their entries forfeited.

This trial is limited to ASCA Registered Australian Shepherds. This trial is not part of the PASA Silver Buckle competition.

Remember: **No smoking** within 100' of any trial site facility.

Vendors: There will be a food vendor and maybe others at the agility site. Other vendors will be in the general vendor area.

Attach copy of Height card: If your dog's standard jump height is not 20+” or 24” , please attached a copy of an ASCA, AKC, or NADAC height card to save time for both of us at the trial. That means all dogs with a wither height less than or equal to 20 inches.

Food: Vendor on Site.

PASA is going GREEN! PASA will keep competitors supplied all day with cold water. BUT in an effort to reduce the impact of our trials on our natural resources, we will not provide disposable cups or bottled beverages. You must bring your own travel mug or drinking bottle to fill up as needed.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

This trial will be held under the current rules and regulations of ASCA. Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial. A copy of ASCA's Agility Rulebook may be downloaded free from the ASCA web site: www.asca.org.

All dogs must be on a leash when not competing in the ring or in the warm up area. No set ups or spectators with dogs within 15 feet of any ring or trial structures such as check-in, awards, scoring areas.

Safety shall always be the foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times. In all cases, regardless of the situation, the judge's decisions are final.

No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA agility or all ASCA programs; or a member/person not in good standing with ASCA. The organizing committee may refuse any entry on the basis expressly provided through ASCA rules and regulations or guidelines established by the ASCA Board of Directors.

Equipment list: Jumps, double jump, separable tire, tunnels, 24" weave poles, teeter, dog walk and A-frame. All contacts are rubberized and slat-less. A-frame will be set at 5'3". Electronic timing will be used.

Note: Junior Handlers are under 18 years. Novice A is for dogs, owners and handlers who have never earned an agility title in **any** venue.

Refunds: No refunds are given for entries withdrawn after the closing date. No refund is given if a dog or handler is dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason. No refund is given if the trial cannot open or be completed due to riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of god, public emergency, acts of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the Show Committee's control. The show will not be cancelled in the event of rain. Refunds will be issued for injured dogs or bitches in season if submitted to the trial secretary in writing by 8 a.m. on Saturday before the trial. A letter from your vet indicating the dog's condition may be requested in order to process the refund.

Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$35.00 service charge for returned checks. Payment of entry fees and service charges shall be made in cash or money order within 30 days of postmark of notice of returned check. ASCA will be notified if any fees are not received within 30 days of notice. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event or entry is cancelled without recourse.

Please clean up after yourself and your dog. Please also keep hotel rooms and grounds clean so that hotels will continue to allow dogs to stay.

The Show Committee will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause.

It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Please take responsibility for your dogs and children. Any exhibitor whose dogs or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee be asked to leave the show site. There will be no refunds for entries if a dog or handler is dismissed from competition for any reason. That includes violating the no smoking rule.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry the signor also agrees that:

- 1.1 As used here: ASCA means Australian Shepherd Club of America, its affiliate clubs, and each of their members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2 Exhibitor/owner agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA, and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3 Exhibitor/owner certifies that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property.
- 1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledges all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the grounds, lighting, security measures or lack thereof, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals, and people; exhibitor/owner assumes the risk of any harm arising for these.
- 1.5 Exhibitor/owner releases ASCA, the ASCA affiliate, Peninsula Australian Shepherd Association, Central Valley Australian Shepherd Club, Kern County Fair Grounds, 15th District Agriculture Association, site owners (including all Officers, agents and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury, or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
