ASCA Sanction Pending. All ASCA show/trial rules and regulations at date of trial apply. Open to ASCA registered Australian Shepherds only. 120 entries per judge limit, we will maintain a waiting list.

7:00am - 7:30am Check-in only

Ring 1: Karen Black (TX) 8:00am Masters walk-thru, 8:30 Masters first run jump heights low to high followed by Advanced with lunch at judge's discretion

Ring 2: Ray Fryar (TX) 8:15am Excellent walk-thru, 8:30 Excellent first run jump heights high to low followed by Novice with lunch at judge's discretion

All classes will run C, B, A. You must notify the gate steward of any conflicts prior to the start of your class.

Non-Regular Pairs Novice will be judged by whichever judge finishes Regular classes first.

## AWARDS RULES and ELIGIBILITY

All scores will first have the HIT Calculation Points added per ASCA Rally Rulebook 1.18.3.

- High Combined for dogs entered in both Excellent B and Masters B. Ties broken per ASCA rules.
- High in Trial for dogs entered in any level A or B class. Ties broken per ASCA rules.
- High in Trial 'C' class for dogs enter in any level C class. Ties broken per ASCA rules.
- High in Trial Junior Handler for dogs handled by anyone 17 years or younger on June 1st of the current ASCA year competing entered in any level A or B class. Ties broken per ASCA rules.

**For special recognition awards please note your eligibility on included SRA Eligibility form (below) with ranking of importance to you. Include one for each dog. Special recognition awards are limited to one win per entry.**

All scores will first have the HIT Calculation Points added per ASCA Rally Rulebook 1.18.3.

- High in Trial Veteran for dogs born before 11/05/2012. Ties will be broken by 1 – older dog, 2 – Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A, C), 3 – time and 4 – runoff.
- High in Trial Bred by Exhibitor for dogs handled by an owner or co-owner of record who is also a breeder of record or handled by an immediate family member of the breeder who maintains ownership of the dog. Ties broken by 1 – Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A, C), 2 – time and 3 – runoff.
- High in Trial Champion of Record for dogs confirmed ASCA Champions of Record. Ties broken by 1 – Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A, C), 2 – time and 3 – runoff.
- High in Trial WTCH for dogs confirmed ASCA WTCH or higher title. Ties broken by 1 – title (SDCH, WTCH-X, WTCH-M, WTCH), 2– Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A, C), 3 – time and 4 – runoff.
- High in Trial nonWTCH Stockdog for dogs with confirmed ASCA stockdog title below a WTCH. Ties broken by 1 – division (PATD, ADV, OPN, STD), 2 – class of stock (c, s, d), 3 – Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A, C), 4 – time and 5 – runoff.
- High in Trial Farm/Ranch Stockdog for dogs with confirmed ASCA farm trial, ranch trial or ranch dog title. Ties broken by 1 – title (FTCH, AFTD, OFTD, RTD, RD), 2 – class of stock (c, m, s, d), 3 – Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A, C), 4 – time and 5 – runoff.
- High in Trial OTCH for dogs with confirmed ASCA OTCH title or higher. Ties broken by 1 – title (OTCH2, OTCH-O2, OTCH, OTCH-O), 2 – Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A, C), 3 – time and 4 – runoff.
- High in Trial nonOTCH Obedience dog for dogs with confirmed ASCA obedience title. Ties broken by 1 – title (UDX, UDX-O, UD, CDX, ODX, CD), 2 – Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A, C), 3 – time and 4 – runoff.
- High in Trial ATCH for dogs with confirmed ASCA ATCH or higher title. Ties broken by 1 – title (ATCH-III, ATCH-II, ATCH), 2– Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A, C), 3 – time and 4 – runoff.
- High in Trial nonATCH Agility for dogs with confirmed ASCA agility title below an ATCH. Ties broken by 1 – division (Elite, Open, Novice), 2 – class (Gamblers, Regular, Jumper), 3– Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A, C), 4 – time and 5 – runoff.
- High in Trial Tracking dog for dogs with confirmed ASCA tracking title. Ties broken by 1 – title (MTCH, UTDX, TDX, TDU, TD, BTD), 2 – Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A, C), 3 – time and 4 – runoff.
- High in Trial Dock Jumping dog for dogs with confirmed ASCA dock jumping title. Ties broken by 1 – level (CH, Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov), 2 – division (Ultra, Pro, Elite, Fly, Deluxe, Classic, Spring), 3– Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A, C), 4 – time and 5 – runoff.
- High in Trial MVA National Competitor for dogs entered in the 2019 ASCA National as an MVA competitor. Ties broken by 1 – Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A, C), 2 – time and 3 – runoff.
- High in Trial MVJ National Competitor for dogs entered in the 2019 ASCA National as an MVJ competitor. Ties broken by 1 – Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A, C), 2 – time and 3 – runoff.
- High in Trial European Competitor for dogs with confirmed European ownership. Ties broken by 1 – Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A, C), 2 – time and 3 – runoff.

# WASCO Rally Around the Stock

## 2019 National Rally Pre-Trial    Bakersfield, CA    Monday, 11/04

### GENERAL

- This trial will be run under ASCA rules and regulations (<http://www.asca.org/home/business-office/rules-forms/>).
- Only open to ASCA registered Australian Shepherds.
- The age of all dogs will be calculated as of November 1, 2019.
- No bitches in season will be allowed to participate in any Rally class at this trial.
- WASCO reserves the right to substitute a judge, if necessary.

### RESPONSIBILITIES

- Owners/handlers are responsible for their dog(s). Dogs must be crated or on lead at all times, except when competing.
- WASCO, its' officers and members, ASCA, its Board of Directors and the property owner assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor, handler, dog, property, child or spectator. Knowing this, you assume full liability for yourself, your dog and any minors under your control and accept full responsibility for any damage caused by you and/or your dog.
- Please respect the grounds and clean up after yourself and your dogs to maintain the premises in a clean and tidy condition!
- If you would like a place to sit, please bring your chair.

### ENTRIES & FEES

- All entries must be on ASCA entry forms with proper fees included (<http://www.asca.org/home/business-office/rules-forms/>).
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of the ASCA Rules & Regulations. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- Entries must have clearly visible USPS postmark. No meter mail allowed. No telephone, facsimile, email or incomplete entries will be accepted.
- Pre-entries postmarked before July 1, 2019 will not be accepted. Pre-entries close October 1, 2019.
- Entries received without proper signature, fees, information, post-dated checks, etc. will be deemed incomplete and will not be accepted as valid entries. Entry fee must be paid by check, cashier's check or money order in US funds.
- WASCO will deposit entry fees as they are received. Any checks returned for insufficient funds will be considered a void entry. There is a \$50 service charge for returned checks. If entries are resubmitted, payment must be in the form of money order or cashier's check in US funds.
- Cancellation of entries must be in writing and postmarked or emailed no later than October 1, 2019 to receive full refund. Refunds will be issued no later than November 20, 2019. No refunds will be given for cancellations made after close of pre-entries unless run is filled from waitlist.
- No entry will be accepted from persons or for dogs not in good standing with ASCA.
- The entry limit will be accepted in postmark order. If the trial is full the dog will be put on a waitlist in order of receipt.
- Confirmation of entries will be made via e-mail after entries close, on or about October 10, 2019.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified by a judge, or barred from competition by the trial committee.
- Entry fees will be refunded if dog is excused in writing by a veterinarian.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if the show/trial cannot open or be completed due to riots, civil disturbances, fire and/or dangerous weather conditions, acts of God, public emergencies, acts of public enemy, strikes or other causes beyond the control of WASCO.
