February 7th -

Demon Copperhead by Barbara Kingsolver (Amazon \$19.50 Hardcover) Set in the mountains of southern Appalachia, Demon Copperhead is the story of a boy born to a teenaged single mother in a single-wide trailer, with no assets beyond his dead father's good looks and copper-colored hair, a caustic wit, and a fierce talent for survival.

March 6th -

The Over Story by Richard Powers (Amazon Paperback \$15.60 - 473 pgs.) There is a world alongside ours—vast, slow, interconnected, resourceful, magnificently inventive, and almost invisible to us. This is the story of a handful of people who learn how to see that world and who are drawn up into its unfolding catastrophe.

April 3rd

The Book of Longings by Sue Monk Kidd (Amazon Paperback \$14.99 - 433 pgs.) This is a story of an inspiring, unforgettable account of one woman's bold struggle to realize the passion and potential inside her, while living in a time, place and culture devised to silence her.

May 1st -

The Irish Boarding House by Sandy Taylor (Amazon Paperback \$9.99 - 300 pgs.) The boarding house brings Mary Kate love and friendships she never dreamed of, but just as her heart is about to burst with joy, a new guest arrives. The stern older woman won't speak about her past, but when Mary Kate uncovers her story, it reveals a devastating secret about her mother.

June 5th -

Pearl that Broke Its Shell by Nadia Hashim (Amazon Paperback \$11.79 - 452 pgs.)

Afghan American Nadia Hashimi's literary debut novel is a searing tale of powerlessness, fate, and the freedom to control one's own fate that combines the cultural flavor and emotional resonance of the works of Khaled Hosseini, Jhumpa Lahiri, and Lisa See.

EXTRA - **Hello Beautiful** by Ann Napolitano (Amazon Hardcover \$15.56 - 416 pgs.) An exquisite homage to Louisa May Alcott's timeless classic, Little Women, Hello Beautiful is a profoundly moving portrait of what is possible when we choose to love someone not in spite of who they are, but because of it.
