Our Mission - The mission of the Center is to enhance the quality of life for the citizens in Estacada and the surrounding area, with an emphasis on seniors and the disabled, by providing nutritional, social, recreational, and educational services, thereby helping them remain safely in their homes.

Who Are We – The Center is formally incorporated as **Friends of Estacada Community Center, Inc., AKA: Estacada Community Center & Estacada Senior Center**: a 501c (3) public benefit non-profit corporation with members.

Who We Serve - The Center primarily serves seniors and qualifying individuals with disabilities in the greater Estacada area - Barton, Damascus, Dodge, Eagle Creek, Garfield, George, Porter, and Springwater.

How we help! Nutrition - During the prior fiscal year our volunteers and staff **delivered 26,490 meals to 164 homebound clients**, driving 18K+ miles with volunteers donating their time, driving their own vehicles. The Center also served **2,481 in person meals** at the Center. The Center partnered with Estacada Food Bank, Dave's Killer Bread, FIDO animeals (pet food) and other local farmers to provide extra food to help home bound clients and their pets. Volunteer delivery drivers delivered over **700 food boxes**. **Transportation** – The Center provided **1771 rides** to the Center, local points of interest, shopping, field trips, and appointments in Estacada. **Recreational and Social** – The Center provided **350 fitness classes** all classes are donation based and most are volunteer lead. **Reassurance, Resources and Assistance** - The Center **assisted 1,410 clients** with resources, information and care calls and visits.

How can you help? Become a member – Includes the mailing of the monthly newsletter and the opportunity to vote for board member/s when there is more than 1 person running in an open position. **Become a Volunteer** – The Center is seeking meals on wheels drivers, typical commitment is an average of 2 hours p/week, 1 route, using own vehicle and volunteer drivers helping seniors get to appointments out of the local area. **Donate** – designate your donation as a memorial, Meals on Wheels, as general support for the operating budget or for a special project or program. **Sponsor the Center** - Businesses/Corporations can be a sponsor of the Center and be recognized on our webpage for the 2026 calendar year (see attached). **Participate in your Employer Giving campaign** – Consider giving through your employer giving campaign and/or matching gifts to Friends of Estacada Community Center, Inc. as a local non-profit donation. **Donate/Participate in fundraisers and events**– The Center collects auction items, food donations and other items for Dinner Dance fundraisers, Bingo, Bunco and craft events call the Center for details on how you can help!

MAJOR GOALS FOR THIS DRIVE

- **Nutrition & Social Programs**-Federal assistance for nutrition funding has declined and is expected to continue to decline 20%-25% this fiscal year with continued declines expected next fiscal year, especially in the Meals on Wheels program.
- **Building** – The Center is the recipient of a Community Development Grant which provides funds to replace old worn-out siding. The project was moved and is expected to be completed by March of 2026 with an additional unexpected cost increase of approx. \$21,000 to complete.
- **Transportation**—Work with Clackamas County and the community to attract volunteers for County transportation programs helping seniors obtain rides to appointments out of the area.
