How far in advance should we send save the date for wedding?

Here's how we roll with our save the dates: Pop them in the mail! We suggest sending them out about 6 months before your big day. If you're planning a destination wedding, bump that timeline up a bit—aim for 8 to 12 months in advance

How far in advance should we send the invitations for wedding?

For wedding invitations, we typically recommend sending them out 8 to 12 weeks before the big day. This gives your guests plenty of time to RSVP and make any necessary arrangements to attend. If you're planning a destination wedding or have guests coming from out of town, consider sending them out a bit earlier, around 5 months in advance, to allow for travel arrangements.

Do we have to give all guest a +1

At Koordinator, we firmly believe in sending invitations only to those whom you truly want to have around you. After all, it's your wedding day, and you should have only those guests who matter most to you!
