

JCHS National Honor Society Point System

An NHS Member in Good Standing is a JCHS student who has at the time of graduation maintained a 9.4 GPA, has not had any marks against his/her character, and has accrued **100 or more points** to show that they have grown in leadership skills, service, and have been active in the chapter. Members in good standing will be identified in the graduation program and will be allowed to wear the NHS stole over their gowns at graduation.

Active Member Points

- For serving in a leadership capacity over your high school career: Officers- 25 points, Committee Chairmen- 20 points, Photographer - 15
- 25 points for attending 4 NHS events over your high school career
- 25 points for attending 10 NHS meetings over your high school career
- 25 points for completing 20 hours of community service over your high school career
(must have documentation/signature for proof of service if completed outside of an NHS project)
- 5 points for each additional event or meeting attended past point requirements
- 5 points for each additional 5 hours of community service
- 5 points for buying an NHS t-shirt
- 5 points for paying your dues by May 15 of your junior year
- 5 points for donating blood at the blood drive
- 5-10 points for contributing to forms/activities **only** if specified by an officer or advisor
