### **Talking points / script**

- **“Hello, I hope you are having a good day, may I take a few moments of your time?”**
- **“I am calling to ask about a report being submitted to the Ethics, Elections and Open Government Committee, a report regarding the certification of voting systems. Can you summarize for me what is the purpose of this report?”**

*[LISTEN WHILE THEY ANSWER. TAKE NOTES.]*

- **“Thank you for sharing that information. I would like to request a copy of the report. How soon can you fill a freedom of information request for a PDF version of the report?”**

*[LISTEN WHILE THEY ANSWER. TAKE NOTES.]*

- **“Thank you.”**

*[VERIFY YOUR INSTRUCTIONS TO MAKE THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST. TAKE NOTES.]*

- **“Thank you. My last request is for direction on how to sign up to speak at the December 14<sup>th</sup> Ethics, Elections and Open Government Committee meeting to share my thoughts on the report. Please walk me through the process of speaking at the meeting, from start to finish.**

*[LISTEN WHILE THEY ANSWER. TAKE NOTES.]*

- **“Thank you. I’m looking forward to participating more in the legislative process and I appreciate your help today. Have a great day and I’ll be in touch next week about the report.”**

## Activism Instructions

- Make phone calls to the members of the Ethics, Elections and Open Government Committee. Use the script above as a guide. Be passionate, respectful, and cordial while you speak to the Representative's aide. Consider this phone call as an inquiry about **these three things**:
  - **Ask what's the purpose of the Secretary of State's report that is being given to the Committee.**
  - **Ask how quickly the Representative's office can fill a freedom of information request for a PDF file of the report.**
  - **Request specific instructions for how to sign up to speak at the December 14<sup>th</sup> committee meeting.**
- Take notes and write down any email addresses, sign up links, websites or other information about the report and signing up to speak.
- Confirm the best day to follow-up next week and discuss legislation that's been filed, House Bill 359.
- Once you're finished with the phone call, please write up a one-page summary and email it to [Dan.Cook@oakesfarms.com](mailto:Dan.Cook@oakesfarms.com) This will help to determine how to strategize the next call to action.
