



**A Resolution of The Collier County Republican Executive Committee Calling
for all elected officials to honor their oath of office by defending American
sovereignty against the United Nations World Health Organization**

Whereas, the United Nations World Health Organization is attempting to establish a global governing body to respond to so-called “international health emergencies,” per the International Health Regulations (2005); and,

Whereas, the Biden Administration has previously attempted to make amendments to the International Health Regulations that usurp the independence and sovereignty of the United States of America by ceding governing authority to the WHO; and,

Whereas, per the 10th Amendment to the Constitution of the United States, The Federal Government does not have the authority to govern over the health of the American people and therefore does not have the authority to cede sovereignty over to the World Health Organization; and,

Whereas, Article VI, Clause 2 of the Constitution of the United States states in part “This Constitution, and the Laws of the United States which shall be made in Pursuance thereof; all Treaties made, or which shall be made, under the Authority of the United States, shall be the supreme Law of the Land...” and,

Whereas, Article 1, Section 1, of the Florida Constitution states, “All political power is inherent in the people...” and,

Whereas, Article 1, Section 23 of the Florida Constitution states, “Every natural person has the right to be let alone and free from governmental intrusion into the person’s private life except as otherwise provided herein...” and,

Whereas, Article 1, Section 5 of the Florida Constitution states, “The people shall have the right peaceably to assemble, to instruct their representatives, and to petition for redress of grievances,” therefore be it

Resolved, that the Collier County Republican Executive Committee hereby petitions our Republican representatives to take the following actions in defense of the people’s sovereignty:

- City Councils: Introduce an Ordinance stating that the United Nations and World Health Organization has zero jurisdiction in the City, and giving that City’s chief of police the authority to arrest and detain any agent, including but not limited to soldiers, public health officials, so-called Regional officials, “teams of experts,” or any domestic public officials or private citizens operating in coordination with the United Nations World Health Organization who collect data, monitor public health, surveil the people or violate the rights of the people in any way.
- Collier County Commissioners: Introduce an Ordinance stating that the United Nations and World Health Organization have zero jurisdiction in Collier County, and giving the County Sheriff the authority to arrest and detain any agent, including but not limited to soldiers, public health officials, so-called Regional officials, “teams of experts,” or any domestic public officials or private citizens operating in coordination with the United Nations World Health Organization who collect data, monitor public health, surveil the people or violate the rights of the people in any way.
- County Sheriff: Read, study, teach, uphold and defend the Constitution for the United States of America.
- State Legislators: Introduce a 10th amendment Resolution stating that any and all actions of Congress outside their scope of duties under Article I, Section 8 of the US Constitution are reserved to the States or to the people.
- US Representatives: Establish a Commission on the 10th Amendment to identify all laws in violation of Article 1, Section 8 of the Constitution of the United States.
- US Senators: Establish a Commission on the 10th Amendment to identify all laws in violation of Article 1, Section 8 of the Constitution of the United.
- US President: Dissolve all agencies, departments, programs, expenditures, corporations and policies that the Congress deems a violation of the 10th Amendment.
- Governor: Create an Executive Order stating that the United Nations and World Health Organization have zero jurisdiction in the State of Florida, and giving State of Florida Law Enforcement the authority to arrest and detain any agent, including but not limited to soldiers, public health officials, so-called Regional officials, “teams of experts,” or any domestic public officials or private citizens operating in coordination with the United Nations World Health Organization who collect data, monitor public health, surveil the people or violate the rights of the people in any way.
