Petition to Sheriff to Enforce Article VI, Section 3 of the Constitution

Whereas, Article VI, Section 3 of the Constitution for the united States of America states, "The Senators and Representatives before mentioned, and the Members of the several State Legislatures, and all executive and judicial Officers, both of the United States and of the several States, shall be bound by Oath or Affirmation, to support this Constitution....."

Whereas, the Declaration of Independence embodies the purpose of government, which is to protect the rights of Life, Liberty and the Pursuit of Happiness, and,

Whereas, Article I of the Bill of Rights states, "Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the Government for a redress of grievances," and,

Whereas, Article X of the Bill of Rights states, "The powers not delegated to the United States by the Constitution, nor prohibited by it to the States, are reserved to the States respectively, or to the people," and,

Whereas, Article I, Section 5 of the Florida Constitution states, "The people shall have the right peaceably to assemble, to instruct their representatives, and to petition for redress of grievances," and,

Whereas, we the people, living on the land, have petitioned and are petitioning elected servants in all levels of government to uphold their Oath of Office by abiding by the chains of the Constitution, by NOT infringing upon the rights stated in the Bill of Rights, and by embodying the spirit of liberty declared through the principles of the Declaration of Independence, and,

Whereas, the Declaration of Independence states, "....That to secure these rights, Governments are instituted among Men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed, --That whenever any Form of Government becomes destructive of these ends, it is the Right of the People to alter or to abolish it....," and,

Therefore, We the People, living on the land, lawfully, formally, humbly, and respectfully petition Collier County Sheriff Kevin Rambosk to uphold his Oath to support the Constitution, and meet with the people to receive our petitions and discuss a course of action.
