ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Students from the Tantasqua School district and surrounding communities
- Must be enrolled or accepted to College/University/Trade School
- Field of study to include course/s in environmental preservation, ecological, animal, or nature.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- Application
- A copy of your official transcript. Including a copy of your acceptance letter. Stating you are accepted and enrolled in a College/University/Trade School.
- A typed 1-page essay regarding your projected career choice.
 Why you believe it will be challenging and fulfilling for you. Include any actions you have undertaken that demonstrate an interest in protecting and preserving natural environments or animal habitats. Any personal experience you have had involving hunting, fishing, the outdoors, nature and/or the preservation of the environment.
- Ex. A fond memory perhaps. Experiences involving nature or outdoor activities that made you pursue a possible career in your field of study.
- 3 recommendation letters.
 1 from a teacher or administrator, 2 from community persons not related to you.
