Developments

The preparations for the new Order and Charity are moving at a steady pace with the publication of the Orders constitution, you may have received a copy of the constitution which details the structure and terms of the condition of membership.

We have set a membership cost of £30 per year to cover administration costs for the Order. Those of us who were paid members of KST can pay £15 for this year as we appreciate you have already paid and have joined us here in a new Order. With the cost of living crises continuing we can negotiate the fee on an individual basis. In this Order money will never be a barrier for a person wishing to improve society or to be considered a highly valued Member of an Order.

We have now a supplier for the Orders regalia and the charities outreach bundle. The regalia has been sourced at a highly competitive price, we are fully understanding of economic circumstances in the country and we have anticipated the impact of it. The Order has mantles and tunics which may be used for the day in return for a contribution for the garments upkeep.

A new bank account in the name of the Order is pending, as is another account for the Charity. We will keep you updated as to development regarding this. To this we are now getting the formulation of the work we will be doing as a charity for initiating activity. This will help now as we get nearer to sending off our registration for a charity number.

Please be patient with us there is a lot of work to get this right first time. We are highly appreciative of the continued support that we have received and once we are up and running it will enable us to make a significant difference to our communities.
