KVAC is supposed to be letting me know about the screen; it probably will come in late June/early July with installation to be scheduled after that.

Landscaping/Building: With our last big rainstorm, some mulch washed away; need to look into longer troughs to shoot the water to the sidewalk. That rainstorm also revealed leaks in several places from the roof (the replaced ceiling tiles let me know where it was leaking). According to the roofer, those spots have been addressed. The sculpture has been installed on the back part of the Art Garden. A ribbon cutting is planned for 2:30pm on Thursday, July 9 with the Creative District.

Staff/Board: I have hired Isela Horwart to fill the Library Aide position and she began on June 1. Klaylee has let me know that her last day will be July 25, although I have not yet received a formal resignation letter. I will begin the hiring process for her position the beginning of July.
