## Air Assault Airsoft co -Field Rules-

- All players and bystanders are encouraged to practice the ' if you see something say something' model of safety. anyone that sees an unsafe act should first voice their concern to the individual committing the act, if no change takes place alert a referee immediately. If at any time during gameplay an unsafe act is witnessed immediately call out 'Cease Fire' if you hear a cease fire being called loudly echo the command to alert other players.
- Treat all Replicas 'Airsoft Guns' as if they are loaded.
- Replicas must have a barrel safety cover on, be empty of all ammo and magazines, and the safety selector must be on safe at all times unless on the playing field or practice range.
- Airsoft rated full face mask, or Airsoft rated sealed goggles plus a covering for face, Mouth, and ears must be worn at ALL times while on playing field or practice range. a Shemagh scarf is acceptable.
- Shooting of replicas outside of playing field or practice range will not be accepted and can result in a permanent ban from all future events.
- Blind firing is not permitted. Blind firing is firing replica without the shooter looking down the line of sight of the replica. it is dangerous to other players as bb path cannot be deemed safe by shooter.
- Players must show respect for the environment as well as any animals encountered on or around the playing area. any individuals caught desecrating the environment or harming/attempting to harm any animals can result in a permanent ban and possible legal prosecution.
- No illegal, or mind altering drugs or alcohol are allowed on the property. All players must be of sound mind and body while playing to keep the sport safe for all involved.
- The field referees have final say on game rules and player disputes, if any player sees or hears something unsafe let a referee know immediately.
