- 3. Artwork must be original and respectful. No artwork with profanity or offensive speech will be permitted.





- TRASH: Monday & Thursday (twice weekly)
- YARD WASTE: Wednesday (once weekly)
- RECYCLING: Friday (once weekly)
- BULK: appointment only





What to recycle:

Visit <u>www.fairfaxcounty.gov/publicworks/recycling-and-trash</u> for recycling guidance.

Recycling includes ONLY plastic and paper/cardboard and must be un-bagged. <u>Glass is not allowed in recycling.</u> For more information on glass recycling please visit the Fairfax County Website: <u>www.fairfaxcounty.gov/publicworks/recycling-trash/glass</u>

Do NOT include plastic bags of any sort in recycling. Plastic bags jam recycling machines, halting the sorting process and leading to costly repairs.

Beginning Summer, 2022

Spring weather has finally arrived and ARB inspections will be quickly coming up. That means it's the perfect time to begin outdoor home improvements!

Review our ARB guidelines to make sure your home is in compliance with neighborhood requirements.

For changes to the exterior of your home such as adding a deck or replacing/adding a fence, make sure you submit an ARB Application for approval before beginning projects.
