



2022 Texas State Championships & Cowtown Feis FAQ Answers

- Yes! We will be printing dancer cards for you. You can pick those up at registration Friday 6-8pm, starting at 7am on Saturday and Sunday, and any other time the registration desk is open.
- Yes! We will have a resale dress rack at the feis near registration.
- Our Irish dance vendors will be Irish Peach Imports and The Irish Dance Shop. You can also visit Fine Designs Custom Shirts and the Ancient Order of Hibernians!
- Dancers should be ready to compete one hour before their scheduled competition time. We will do our best to post on our FB page if we are running early (or late), but it will be better to rely on announcements made in the ballrooms.
- Champs competitions will start in hard shoe both days.
- Dancers will not be dancing one at a time unless the judges specifically request them to do so. Our stages are large enough for dancers not to have "close contact" as defined by CDC rules.
- Sunday's feis is a blackout feis, wigs optional. U14 and up must wear black tights with blackout. If competitions are combined, dancers in any competition which includes U14 dancers are expected to wear tights.
- The current State of Texas facemask guidance reads: "No governmental entity, including a county, city, school district, and public health authority, and no governmental official may require any person to wear a face covering or to mandate that another person wear a face covering;" (GA-38) Businesses may decide to set and/or enforce their own policies. We refer everyone to the hotel's policy linked on our website under covid guidance. In our experience, few businesses in DFW currently enforce face masks for guests.
