4. Advanced Manufacturing & Robotics
5. Global Business Services & BPO
6. Tourism & Cultural Economy
7. HealthTech & Biotechnology
8. Automotive, Logistics & Supply Chain Innovation
9. Creative & Sports Industries
10. Space, Mining 2.0 & Advanced Materials

By nurturing these industries, South Africa can create 2.35 million jobs by 2030, attract billions in FDI, and retain critical talent. But this is not all, since a job is just one of many opportunities open to the SA Youth.

Connecting South Africa's Youth to Global Opportunities

South Africa's greatest resource is not its minerals, land, or coastline. It is its youth — energetic, creative, and resilient. Yet more than half of young South Africans remain unemployed. The tragedy is not a lack of global opportunities; it is the lack of structured bridges that connect our youth to them.

A young coder in Cape Town can contribute to a New York project; a marketing graduate in Durban can support a Berlin start-up. These real-world experiences build confidence, skills, and networks.
3. **The Mentorship Bank:** A single mentor can transform a life. The Future of Jobs Summit™ is building a global “mentorship bank” of leaders committed to guiding South African youth through monthly calls, project reviews, and network introductions. Mentorship creates not only skills but belief.
4. **The Innovation Exchange:** Many of our young people are entrepreneurs. By connecting youth-led start-ups to global accelerators, investors, and markets, we can scale ideas born in South Africa to serve customers worldwide.

Not every breakthrough comes from a full-time job. Sometimes it is a short-term internship, a single scholarship, or a one-hour mentorship conversation. These small but meaningful connections build momentum, expand networks, and unlock far larger doors.
