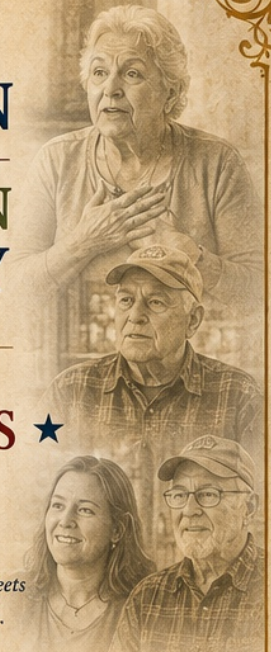

As America celebrates its 250th anniversary, *Tri-County Mystery Meets* is preserving the stories of the people who call Appalachia home.

Through the *Voices 250 Project*, our goal is to interview 250 individuals in one year, capturing memories, experiences, traditions, and personal histories that might otherwise be lost. Selected stories are then transformed into original theatrical productions, allowing audiences to see their communities reflected on stage.

Inspired in part by interviews conducted through *Voices 250*, the production celebrates love, resilience, family, and the enduring spirit of Appalachian people.
