




2nd & 3rd grade skill level project:


Drawing Overlapping Buildings using layering

 have to look exactly like this one.




Supplies: Permanent marker
 Watercolor paint




1. Make guide lines. Draw rectangles.




2. Add roof on each.




3. Draw second layer of buildings.




4. Add roof on each building.




5. Fill back with more buildings.



6. Add diagonal roof lines.



7. Draw all types of windows.



8. Fill windows with black marker.
 Paint all carefully with paint
