
LEARNING TO DRAW BUILDINGS USING Overlapping & Layering Visual Art Ms. Drakes




2nd & 3rd grade skill level project:


Drawing Overlapping Buildings using layering All new steps are drawn in pink. Your picture does not have to look exactly like this one.




Supplies: Permanent marker Watercolor paint




3. Draw second layer of buildings.




6. Add diagonal roof lines.




1. Make guide lines. Draw rectangles.




4. Add roof on each building.




7. Draw all types of windows.

8. Fill windows with black marker. Paint all carefully with paint
