Job Description

Position Title: Ascent Director

Reports to: Director of Children's Ministries & ADC Camp Director

Purpose: Facilitate and spur on growth in the Leaders in Training who volunteer their time at Adventurers Day Camp. The person in this position should have a passion for seeing these young people grow in their faith and leadership abilities while at camp, and will plan sessions and events to accomplish this goal.

Specific Responsibilities:

1. Work with the Director of Children's Ministry & Director of Youth Ministry to continue to develop the Ascent Program.
2. Participate in the LIT Meet-and-Greet, a new event that will take place pre-summer as a way to get to know new LIT's, evaluate their abilities, answer questions, and build connections.
3. Create an overall theme specifically for the LIT's this summer (bonus points if it can tie in to the ADC theme), including a theme verse for them.
4. Plan and lead the LIT-specific sessions of Staff Training, working with the ADC Directors for scheduling these times, and working with the WEFC Directors for support and ideas for these sessions.
5. Attend the Morning Staff Meetings, and lead the LIT Morning Meeting (if required).
6. Meet one-on-one with each LIT each week they work to pray with them, talk with them, answer questions, challenge them, and/or encourage them. Keep track of where they are at spiritually, and emotionally, working with the Directors to ensure that their Leaders are supporting them and challenging them well each week.
7. Work with the Camp Director to distribute and collect the 'Leader Evaluation by LIT' forms.
8. Work with the WEFC Directors to plan and lead the LIT Development sessions that run throughout the summer.
9. Provide assistance to the Program Directors and Camp Director, should they need during the course of each week.
10. Alongside the WEFC Directors, plan and lead Summit – our end of summer mini-camp for all the LIT's who worked this summer at ADC.
11. Plan the ADC Reunion event with the rest of the Leadership Team after the summer.
12. Work with the ADC Committee after the summer sessions are complete, in the evaluation of the overall program – including the Ascent Program.
13. Other duties as assigned by the Director of Children's Ministry.
