Specific Responsibilities:

- 4. To assist their assigned Leader in a daily Small Group Time.

- Be ready and willing to take on any other tasks that may be assigned to you by any member of the ADC Leadership Team, ADC Leaders, or the Director of Children's Ministry. These other tasks may include:
