Job Description

Position Title: ADC Group Leader

Purpose: To care for a group of campers, seeking to lead them in such a way so that each one will have a fun and safe experience at ADC, with each one having an opportunity to receive Christ as Saviour and/or grow in their relationship with Him.

Reports to: ADC Camp Director

Position Dates: July 1 – August 26, 2025

Skills, Experience, Qualifications, and Characteristics:

- Strong faith in God with a heart to serve.
- Experience serving with children, with a passion for ministry.
- Enthusiastic and a willingness to learn and try new things.
- Ability to communicate and clearly explain the Gospel.
- Capacity for building relationships with children and other staff members.
- Specialized Training such as Lifeguard Certification and Standard First Aid/CPR are assets.
- For applicants 18 years of age or older, having a valid drivers licence with access to a vehicle for the summer is an asset.

Applicants must be at least 17 years or age OR turn 17 on or before December 31, 2025.

Specific Responsibilities:

1. Attend Staff Training week, engaging and participating in each session.
2. Attend morning Staff Meetings.
3. Care for the physical, emotional, and social well-being of each member of their assigned group.
4. Build intentional relationships with the campers in their group. Seek to understand where each camper is in their personal relationship to God and provide encouragement and support to campers in their areas of need.
5. Discipline individual campers when necessary, doing so in a Godly manner in accordance with camp guidelines.
6. Supervise and assist your small group in keeping any areas of use clean, including meal areas.
7. Lead their group in a daily Small Group Time, as outlined by the ADC Directors.
8. Engage in a mentorship relationship with Leaders-in-Training throughout the summer, as assigned by the ADC Directors. Provide intentional encouragement, feedback, and connection.
9. Assist the Lead Team in the execution of programming, as assigned. This could include but is not limited to; Operating Check In/Out Stations, Leading a "Station" (Crafts, Games, etc). Prep for future camp weeks.
10. Assist the Directors in the follow-up ministry of ADC through whatever tasks they assign.
11. Be ready and willing to take on any other tasks that may be assigned to you by the ADC Lead Team, and/or the Director of Children's Ministry.
