

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

LAUREL RIDGE SUBDIVISION WATER SYSTEM FLUORIDE MCL VIOLATION

It has been noted that our community water system has fluoride that continues to be in excess of the standards. You have a right to know what happened, what you should do, and what we are doing to correct this situation.

We routinely monitor for the presence of drinking water contaminants. We have been notified by the State that **our water system exceeded the maximum contaminant level (MCL) for Fluoride**. The MCL for Fluoride is 4 mg/L. During the 4/01/2024 – 06/11/2024 compliance period we believe that the fluoride level will have continued to exceed the recommended limit.

What should you do?

- There is nothing you need to do. **You do not need to boil** your water or take other corrective actions. However, if you have specific health concerns, consult your doctor.
- If you have a severely compromised immune system, have an infant, are pregnant, or are elderly, you may be at increased risk and should seek advice from your health care provider about drinking this water.

What is being done? We continue to work with American Water Specialties as they pursue our pilot program to reduce fluoride.
