- A. Miller (578 Wolf Hole Road) Discussion ensued regarding the potential sewage issues. Ed Fisher informed the Supervisors that they could approve a Waiver of Land Development. To consider approval, there would need to be a written agreement between the Landowner(s), Jackson Township, and the Sewage Enforcement Officer (SEO), Brian McFeaters. David Faust moved to approve the Waiver of Land Development subject to the terms described herein. Charlie Bisking seconded, and the motion carried 2-0.
- B. Fire & EMS Contributions Discussion ensued regarding funding for the Fire & EMS locally. Options for additional funding include Fire Tax, EMS Tax, and LST. More research is required.
