- -Carl Subdivision The plan is a stormwater plan, not a land development plan. The project is primarily in Jefferson Township, only the driveway is in Jackson Township. They have proposed 5 pipes in the driveway and a 325-foot infiltration basin.
- -Road Bids Bidding should begin is a decision to proceed with projects is made.
- -Dietrich Road A concrete squash pad is proposed for the project. Discussion will occur during the road inspection tour (to be held March 22, 2024 @ 9:00am). Assuming the estimated cost is within budget, the project can go to bid.
