

Jackson Township Board of Supervisors

November 6, 2024

CALL TO ORDER: Chairman Charlie Bisking called the meeting to order at 7:05pm.

ROLL CALL: Present: Chairman, Charlie Bisking; Vice-Chairman, David Faust; Supervisor, Justin Hoover; Shane Liddick (representing Hoover Financial) Secretary/Treasurer; Engineer, Ed Fisher; Solicitor, Linus Fenicle; EMC, Don Shutt; and 8 citizens were present. Tax Collector, Dale Faust was absent.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

None.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Justin Hoover moved to approve the October 2, 2024 meeting minutes as presented. David Faust seconded, and the motion carried 3-0.

TREASURER REPORT:

- A. Financial Reports – Financial reports were provided with the Supervisors' Meeting Packets.
 - B. Bills/Wages – A check register was provided and reviewed.
- David Faust moved to approve the Financial Reports and the Payment of Bills as presented. Justin Hoover seconded, and the motion carried 3-0.

CORRESPONDENCE:

None.

EMC REPORT:

Don Shutt presented his 2025 budget and a reimbursement request for training courses. The Jackson Township portion of the budget is \$3,037.95 and the Jackson Township portion of the training course is \$45.00. Charlie Bisking moved to approve reimbursement as presented. David Faust seconded, and the motion carried 3-0.

Don Shutt further explained that our area is still in a drought watch. Justin Hoover moved to authorize a burn-ban for 30 days from the date of this meeting. David Faust seconded, and the motion carried 3-0.

ROADMASTER REPORT:

- A. Morgan Paving is supposed to be submitting a quote for the paving of the Wolf Hold Road bridge.
- B. No Update on sign orders.
- C. The Dietrich Road project began on 11/6/2024 and the planks for the Wolf Hole Bridge should arrive 11/21 or 11/22. The truck has been repaired and is back from A&L Diesel.

ENGINEER REPORT:

Engineer Ed Fisher shared updates as follows:

-578 Wolf Hole Road – No new inspections were scheduled or conducted and there has not yet been a variance submission. Discussion ensued.

-Deitrich Road – Work on the project began 11/6/2024.

- Wolf Hole Road** – The concrete planks should be set on either 11/21 or 11/22.
- 1333 Forest Lane** – An application for permits is forthcoming.

SOLICITOR REPORT:

- A. Compensation Ordinance - Solicitor Fenicle indicated that an increase in compensation for Township Supervisors would only be applicable to new terms.

OLD BUSINESS:

- A. Fire & EMS Funding – Discussion ensued. Charlie Bisking moved to add a .2 mil tax increase to the 2025 budget. David Faust seconded, and the motion carried 3-0.
- B. Non-Compliance Permitting Fees – No Update
- C. 2025 Budget – Discussion ensued. Charlie Bisking moved to approve advertising the budget with a .2 mil tax increase. David Faust seconded, and the motion carried 3-0.
- D. 3 Mill Drive – No update.

NEW BUSINESS:

- A. Resolution 2024-06 Agricultural Security Area Approval for Glick (32-016-027) – David Faust moved to approve the Resolution as presented.
- B. Resolution 2024-07 Deed of Merger for Shawn Reed & Sherri Keiter-Reed – Justin Hoover moved to approve the Resolution as presented.
- C. Fire Company Vehicle Insurance Payment – Charlie Bisking moved to approve paying the Fisherville Volunteer Fire Co Vehicle Insurance premium of \$5,700. Justin Hoover seconded. The motion carried 2-0 with David Faust abstaining.
- D. Facebook Page – David Faust moved to approve the creation of a Jackson Township, Dauphin County Facebook Page. Justin Hoover seconded, and the motion carried 3-0.

ADJOURNMENT: Justin Hoover moved to adjourn. David Faust seconded, and the motion carried 3-0. Charlie Bisking adjourned the meeting at 8:17pm.
