About the 2025 Kids Feeding Kids Summer Educator Institute (SEI):





The KFKids SEI will train and equip high school FACS educators teaching foods-related classes or educators of culinary arts technical classes with the training, materials, and funding to complete two (2) KFKids projects in their individual classrooms during the 25-26 SY.

Educators invited to attend the SEI will join a cohort of up to 12 educators at one of the regional SEI locations. This experience is designed as a unique opportunity for educator professional development.

As an invited SEI participant you will:

- examine your understanding of food insecurity and practice leading informed instruction about its root causes,
- examine your knowledge of food waste and best practices for safely donating nourishing food,
- share teaching expertise and ideas for skills-based activities for use throughout the school year,
- participate daily in discussion and hands-on cooking labs that will give you the confidence to independently complete KFKids lessons with your students,
- develop a written plan to align a KFKids project into your 2025-2026 unit plans

SEI educators who have fulfilled all expectations of SEI participation:

- will receive a daily stipend of \$125 per day for the investment of their time (max total: \$375)
- will receive a funding commitment from KFKids for two classroom projects in 25-26 SY
- may be called upon to share their expertise through activities that might include conference presentations, participation in professional networking groups, or media interviews
- will have demonstrated their role as an innovative, educational leader

Complete your <u>application</u> before March 14, 2025 to be considered for this invitational opportunity. (PLEASE NOTE: Although we provide information about area lodging <u>we do not pay travel expenses.</u> The information is intended only to help applicants determine geography of each location.)
