The Town Board finds that pursuant to 6 NYCRR 617.5(c)(30) the adoption of a moratorium on land development or construction is a Type II action under the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA") which has been determined not to have a significant impact on the environment or is otherwise precluded from environmental review under Environmental Conservation Law, Article 8 and is therefore not subject to review under 6 NYCRR Part 617 or Environmental Conservation Law Article 8.

### Section 3. Authority

This moratorium is enacted by the Town Board pursuant to its authority to adopt local laws under Article IX of the New York State Constitution and Municipal Home Rule Law Section 10.

## Section 4. Scope of Controls

The Town of Warren shall not grant any approvals that would have as the result of establishment, implementation, placement or construction of any alternative energy development within the Town of Warren.

For purposes of this local law, commercial energy development shall only include commercial energy development that is not otherwise regulated by a local law in the Town. As of the date of this moratorium, solar generation facilities are regulated by Local Law 1 of 2021. This moratorium shall apply to wind generation facilities, battery energy storage and other large-scale generating facilities.

#### Section 5. Hardship.

Should any owner of property affected by this Local Law suffer an unnecessary hardship in the way of carrying out the strict letter of this Local Law, then the owner of said property may apply to the Town Board of the Town in writing for a variance from strict compliance with this Local Law upon submission of proof of such unnecessary hardship.

#### Section 6. Effective Date

This local law shall take effect immediately when it is filed in the Office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
