REGULAR MEETING

Supervisor Crockett called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm and led us in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Supervisor Jeffrey Crockett, Councilpersons: Richard Jack, Dorayne Peplinski, Steve Hula, Leslie Miller, Highway Supt. Darryl Aney and Town Clerk Anna Halkowich.

Mason Road was again discussed. Hwy. Supt. Has 2 quotes to fix this road. One for \$30,420.00 and a second from Suit-Kote for \$16,206.00. Suit-Kotes machinery and crews are already working in our area. The other company will have to bring in all their equipment and crews which is reflected in the more expensive quote. This matter has been turned over to our attorney.

Supervisor Crockett has been notified that the Gelston Castel property owners of 350 Galina Lane which is assessed for \$603,000.00 to \$140,000.00 have filed suit against the Town over their assessment. Jill Gilbert has also filed suit for property owned by her against the Town of

Warren over her assessment on property at 549 Kingdom Road to have it reduced from \$171,000.00 to \$94,000.00. These cases have been filed under article 7 in the Supreme Court of Herkimer County.

Glenn Armstrong, Planning Board, told the Board that “tiny homes” are being discussed. Some for the Gelston Castel property and some for a development on US Hwy 20, on the former Softball complex East of Warren.

He also reported that KOA has not responded to requests for more information from them regarding an upgrade of their solar plans.

He also reported that the Town of Stark cell tower on Mary Hill Road is in the hands of their attorney and entering Part 2 of SEQUAR. All looks ok at this point.

Hwy. Supt. Aney was given permission to search for a different pick-up truck. He plans to look for a ¾ ton pick-up with a plow and trade in the 2020 pick-up. Permission was granted on a motion by R. Jack, and second by S. Hula.
