Discussion Questions: Ethnicity and Gender

- 2. How does Isabella's gender influence the people around her? Jean-Michel? Juan Carlos? Carl? Stiles?
- 3. How does Isabella's background as a slave influence her decisions as commander of the Marèe Rouge?
- 4. Is Isabella conscious of her gender?
- 5. What does the story say about gender dependency, if anything?
- 6. How does Isabella's background as a slave influence the people around her? The pirates on the Marèe Rouge? Juan Carlos? Rosa? Jean-Michel?
- 7. Runaway and escaped slaves were common on pirate ships. Why do you think this was true? What benefits did a pirate ship have over staying on land and hiding in the jungles?
- 8. Juan Carlos sees Rosa and Isabella as similar yet wildly different. How? Who would make the better captain of a pirate ship?
- 9. Some of characterized Isabella as a "modern" woman. Is this an accurate description? What characteristics make up a modern woman? Would these characteristics be more or less accepted among a pirate crew?
- 10. Do you think some characters appeal to boys more than girls? If so, which ones, and why?
- 11. How would you describe Isabella's relationship with Jacob? What role did he play in her life? Does this differ significantly from Jean-Michel?
