



Game Recap #18 (Carlsbad)

The Quick Hit:

The Falcons kicked off their pursuit of an Avocado West League title defense with a 22 point win. Brandon Angel had 23 points in the final three quarters to lead all scorers in the game with 26. Defense was again a big part of the win, particularly when the Lancers were held to two field goals in the second quarter and 22 total points in the first half.

The Players:

Now with his eighth double-double on the season, Brandon Angel had 26 points to go along with 12 rebounds. Though he only got off a less-than-usual three three-point attempts, he connected on two and was an overall 11/15 from the field. Chris Howell was once again the leader in stuffing the stat sheet for the Falcons. His total line: 8 points, 6 rebounds, 9 assists, 2 steals, 3 blocks and only 2 turnovers. Nick Herrmann was the other Falcon to score double digits besides Angel. He had 13 points on 5/7 shooting while also contributing five rebounds and four assists. Cameron Klein was one of two Falcons to shoot 100% from the field (3/3) as he finished with eight points. Dechaun Key also made his only shot attempt.

The Game:

All five starters for the Falcons scored in the first quarter, led by Nick Herrmann's six points. Caleb Nelson did connect on three shots from behind the arc in the quarter, but Torrey Pines led 18-14 after one. Brandon Angel accounted for nearly half of the Falcons' points in the second quarter with eight. Meanwhile, Carlsbad was only able to make two field goals in the second eight minutes. A Cameron Klein three, assisted by Brandon Angel, with three seconds left before halftime stretched the lead to its largest margin of the game – 15 points (37-22). The lead was never threatened from there. After three quarters, the Falcons led 53-34. With two minutes left in the game, starters for both teams were removed from the game. Dechaun Key was able to score the final two points in those minutes en route to a 70-48 win for the Falcons. As a team, the Falcons shot 62% from the field and 71% from three.

Next Up:

The Falcons will host Mission Hills on Friday night at 7:00 pm in the Olive Garden. This will be game #2 in the Avocado West League.
