9 Facts to Know:

1. Torrey Pines defeated Mission Hills 67-36 last Friday night at home to improve to 15-4 overall and 2-0 in the Avocado West. San Marcos fell to Carlsbad on the road and come into tonight's game 12-6 overall with a 1-1 record in the Avocado West.
2. Last season, the Falcons and Knights faced off three times. Torrey Pines took all three games. The first matchup came the *Game On Challenge* Finals, with Bryce Pope leading all scorers with 32 points en route to a 77-71 win. The other two games were in Avocado West League play: 67-58 and 70-60 wins for the Falcons. Mike Pope led the Falcons in each contest with 24 and 26 points.
3. In the Maxpreps era, the Falcons are 6-2 against the Knights. Three of those wins came last season, the subject of fact #2.
4. With the victory over Mission Hills, the Falcons reached the 15 win mark and have clinched a winning record for the season. This is Coach Olive's 21st season with 15+ wins and the 16th season in a row. It will also be his 22nd consecutive season with a .500 record or better.
5. Thus far on the season, the Falcons are allowing 47.3 points per game. This is the best since the 2015-2016 season. That team allowed 45.6 points per game, which was a mark good enough for fourth best in the state.
6. The Falcons and Knights have three common opponents this season: Poway, Carlsbad and Mission Hills. The latter two are Avocado West opponents. Torrey Pines is 3-0 while San Marcos is 1-2, with Mission Hills the lone win in those games.
7. With his 20 points and 15 rebounds Friday night, Brandon Angel (#21) recorded his second straight double-double. The Stanford-bound senior has recorded nine double-doubles in 19 games this season.
8. Coming into tonight, San Marcos sophomore Devon Arlington ranks third in San Diego with 5.3 assists per game. Torrey Pines junior Chris Howell (#5) ranks seventh with 4.4 assists per game.
9. Senior Brandon Angel (#21) comes into the game averaging 20.2 points per game. He would join Bryce Pope's 22.3 points per game in 2017-2018 as the only guys to average 20+ a game in the last eight seasons.
