

Torrey Pines Falcons (17-4, 4-0) vs. Canyon Crest Ravens (9-13, 0-4)

9 Facts to Know:

- 1. Torrey Pines has now won six straight and improved to 4-0 in the Avocado West after last Thursday's win over La Costa Canyon. Down 17 at half, the Falcons clawed back to force overtime and eventually won 68-63. Canyon Crest fell 62-53 at home to Carlsbad in their last contest, and the ball club has now dropped to 0-4 in league.
- 2. The Falcons have never lost to Canyon Crest, a feat that dates back to when the Academy opened its doors in 2004. Torrey Pines is 15-0 against the Ravens.
- 3. Last season, the Falcons and Ravens faced off twice in Avocado West League play. The January 16th, 2019 matchup went to the Falcons 72-35, and the February 6th, 2019 matchup went to the Falcons 71-46. Bryce Pope led the way in both games, the first with 21 points and the latter with 14 points.
- 4. After tonight's game, all teams in the Avocado West will have played each other once. The Falcons maintain sole possession of first place at 4-0. Carlsbad is 3-1, La Costa Canyon and San Marcos are 2-2, Mission Hills is 1-3 and Canyon Crest is 0-4.
- 5. In overtime last season, the Falcons were 1-1. They fell 90-89 in double overtime to Foothills Christian on December 22^{nd} , 2018 but defeated San Marcos 77-71 on the road November 24^{th} , 2018. It was the first OT win in 425 days.
- 6. Brandon Angel (#21) recorded his fourth straight double-double against LCC. This one came with 19 points and 10 rebounds, both of which were team highs. He now has 11 double-doubles for the season.
- 7. Nate Witte (#2) scored a varsity career high with 11 points last game. None were bigger than his go-ahead three with less than a minute left in overtime to put the Falcons up one. His previous high: 10 points on December 2^{nd} , 2019 at West Hills.
- 8. Thank you, Kobe Bryant, for inspiring dozens of players in the Torrey Pines Basketball program throughout their childhood. Rest in peace Mamba.
- 9. In addition to Nate Witte's shot (see fact #7), the comeback win against LCC provided some other huge shots from juniors on the team. Cameron Klein (#12) hit a three at the inside of two minutes left in the game to pull the Falcons within a single basket for the first time in the second half. Chris Howell (#5) got fouled shooting a three with the Falcons down three with 0.8 seconds to go. He hit all three free throws to send the game to overtime and an eventual Falcons win.
