



Torrey Pines Falcons (3-1) @ Granite Hills Eagles (0-2)

9 Facts to Know:

1. The Falcons are 3-1 on the season. Last week's loss to Mater Dei Catholic was avenged two days ago with a 27 point win at home over West Hills. Granite Hills is 0-2 with losses to Bishop's and West Hills (OT).
2. In the 2018-2019 season, Granite Hills lost in the first round of CIF San Diego Division III playoffs to eventual champion San Diego High.
3. In the Maxpreps era (the last 15 years), the Falcons have not faced the Eagles.
4. Nate Witte (#2) has been incredibly efficient for the Falcons. The junior guard is 10/11 from the field including a perfect 3/3 mark from behind the arc. Additionally, he made his first start of the season on Monday against West Hills.
5. Brandon Angel (#21) has now accumulated two straight double-doubles. Against Mater Dei Catholic on November 27th, he had 16 points and 14 rebounds. Last game against West Hills, he had 22 points and 10 rebounds. Angel now has nine career double-doubles.
6. Sophomore Otto Landrum (#35) leads the Falcons in both offensive rebounds and blocks despite having only played three games. He had four blocks last game against the Wolfpack, a season high.
7. This is road game #2 of the season for Torrey Pines. The Falcons will play a total of 10 true road games this season, five in non-conference or tournament scenarios and five in the Avocado West League.
8. Including this game, all five Varsity contests for the Falcons will have been preceded by a JV matchup against the same school. The JV Falcons are 4-0 in those games while Varsity is 3-1. All three levels of Falcon hoops are in action today: Varsity @ Granite Hills, JV @ Granite Hills AND vs. La Jolla Country Day, and Freshman @ Mt. Carmel.
9. On this day in Torrey Pines Basketball history: December 4th, 2010
The Falcons faced off against the Rancho Buena Vista Longhorns in the Hilltop tournament. Future University of San Diego Torero teammates Johnny Dee and Nick Kerr paced each of their ball clubs with 27 points and 22 points respectively. The Falcons won 75-67 en route to a Hilltop tournament title.
