



#2 Torrey Pines Falcons (23-4, 9-0)
vs. La Costa Canyon Mavericks (17-10, 5-3)
Torrey Pines High School - February 13th, 2020 - 7:30 pm



9 Facts to Know:

1. Tuesday's 26-point win over San Marcos was the 12th straight for the Falcons. They have not lost since December 28th, 2019. La Costa Canyon comes in off a 46-42 win over San Marcos last Friday that extended their winning streak to three games. The Mavericks did not play on Tuesday evening.
2. The win on Tuesday evening at the Olive Garden sealed the Avocado West League title for the Falcons. This is the seventh straight league title, 13th of the last 14 years, and Coach Olive's 16th in his 23 years at Torrey Pines.
3. In the last matchup between these two teams, it will forever be one of the classic games in a historic rivalry. Down 17 at half, the Falcons rallied in the second half to force overtime where they eventually pulled out a 68-63 win on the road. This was the ninth straight win for the Falcons in the rivalry, having not lost since Jan. 2014.
4. La Costa Canyon is 3-7 this season in games decided by five points or less, including three overtime contests. One of those involved the previous matchup with the Falcons (fact #3). Torrey Pines is 4-0 in games decided by five points or less with the January 23rd game against the Mavericks being their only overtime game this season.
5. If the Falcons were to win tonight, this would be the seventh undefeated season in league play for Coach Olive. All of the prior six undefeated league slates have been since 2010-2011. Additionally, the Falcons have lost two or fewer league games in every season since 2006-2007.
6. Just two games after passing the 1,000 point mark for his varsity career, becoming only the eighth player in the last 15 years to do so, Brandon Angel (#21) has now moved up to #5 on the leaderboard. His career varsity point total is now 1,061.
7. The Falcons are giving up 47.1 points per game on defense this season. That is on pace to be the best mark since the 2015-2016 team's average of 45.6 points/game.
8. Brandon Angel (#21) is currently averaging a double-double for the season with 20.6 points/game & 10.0 rebounds/game. In the last 15 years, only Jake Gilliam ('17) has accomplished such a feat with his 15.6 & 10.7 averages for the 2016-2017 season.
9. Pending the results of tonight's JV and varsity games, the Torrey Pines Basketball program is 72-5 this season. The Freshman season is complete - they finished 23-0. JV is currently 26-1 and Varsity is 23-4.
