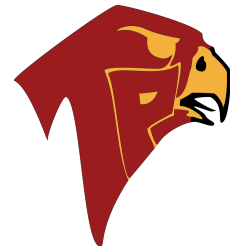




#6 Poway @ #3 Torrey Pines

CIF San Diego Quarterfinal - February 16th, 2019



10 Facts to Know:

1. The Falcons are one of only two schools in San Diego to make the Open Division playoffs every year since its inception for the 2013-2014 season.
2. Coach John Olive goes for his 500th win tonight in his 22nd season at Torrey Pines. His overall record: 499-174. He has also won 23 of his last 25 games against the Titans dating back to 2002.
3. Torrey Pines comes in as the Avocado West League champions after finishing with a 9-1 league record. Poway comes in as the Palomar League champions after finishing with a 7-1 league record.
4. Senior Falcon Bryce Pope (#4) was recently honored as the Avocado West League Player of the Year. This marks the sixth straight season a Falcon has won League Player of the Year.
5. Senior Falcon Michael Pope (#3) was named to the Avocado West First Team. Junior Falcon Brandon Angel (#21) was named to the league's Second Team.
6. In Torrey Pines' last game at La Costa Canyon, senior Michael Pope (#3) became only the seventh Falcon to cross the 1,000 career point mark in the last 15 years. One of the other six? His twin brother Bryce (#4) who crossed that threshold earlier this season.
7. Poway and Torrey Pines met back on November 15th in the Falcons' second game of the season. Led by Michael Pope's (#3) 28 points, Torrey Pines won 74-49.
8. The Falcons come in with four players averaging double digits: Bryce Pope (#4) at 19.3 PPG, Michael Pope (#3) at 17.8 PPG, Noah Viera (#10) at 11.2 PPG and Brandon Angel (#21) at 10.9 PPG.
9. Poway guard Adam Sevier (#3) was named the Palomar League Player of the Year. Center Cole Stephens (#35) was named to the league's First Team.
10. As a team, the Falcons are shooting 57% on two-pointers, 40% from behind the arc and 83% from the foul line.
