



Game Recap #2 (Mt. Carmel)

The Quick Hit:

Despite a slow first half and only an 11 point lead at the break, the Falcons rode a big third quarter on their way to a 75-59 at home over Mt. Carmel.

The Players:

Chris Howell and Nick Herrmann led the Falcons with 17 points each in only three quarters of action. Howell also added five rebounds, four steals and three assists. Logan Huston and Otto Landrum had eight points apiece, with Landrum also contributing four boards. Diego Campisano was the Falcons' leading rebounder with eight. As with game #1 against San Diego, 11 of the 13 Falcons who suited up for the evening had at least one basket.

The Game:

A slow start for both teams resulted in a Falcons lead of six after one quarter, 18-12. In the second, the Falcons began quickly to open up the lead to double digits. However, Mt. Carmel caught fire, shooting a high percentage from everywhere on the floor. The Torrey Pines lead was cut to three points at one point midway through the period, but the Falcons were able to open it back up again shortly before half. The score was 40-29 at the break. Chris Howell spearheaded the Falcons' attack with 11 points in the opening 16 minutes. In the second half, Nick Herrmann had back-to-back and 1s midway through the third quarter. The next possession following those, Herrmann had a nice layup with an assist from Howell. Those possessions helped push the Torrey Pines lead over 20. After three quarters, it was 63-36 Falcons. The Falcons' starters rested for the final eight minutes. A fourth quarter highlight came from Sebastian Fayer. He hustled for an offensive rebound, got on the floor and was eventually rewarded by Nate Witte with an excellent pass for a Fayer and 1. Mt. Carmel lit it up in the last quarter, but it was too little, too late. The final: 75-59 Falcons.
