

## **Torrey Pines Falcons (9-0)**

## 9 Facts to Know:

- 1. The Falcons are coming in to tonight off their third straight 3-0 week to begin the season. Last week's wins came over Temecula Valley, Corona Centennial and Mission Hiils. The Ravens come in having split last Friday/Saturday's doubleheader against Westview, winning the home game but dropping the away contest.
- 2. Torrey Pines was 2-0 against Canyon Crest in the 2019-2020 season. The Ravens have never defeated the Falcons, as the lifetime series currently stands at 17-0.
- 3. Not only are the Falcons off to a hot 9-0 start on the season, every game has begun with a hot start too. Torrey Pines has led at halftime in all nine games.
- 4. The offense led Torrey Pines through the first six games, but lately the defense has been ramping up. In the three wins last week, only an average of 52 points per game were scored by opponents.
- 5. 500 Club! In last Saturday's win over Mission Hills, Nick Herrmann (#1) became the 21<sup>st</sup> Falcon since 2004 to amass 500 or more varsity points scored. With six or more points scored tonight, he will move to #19 on the career points leaders (again, only since '04).
- 6. The offensive depth of the Falcons has been on display game in, game out. In the 2019-2020 season, the Falcons only had one player average double digits: current Stanford freshman Brandon Angel. This year, the Falcons have three averaging double figures: Nick Herrmann (18.2 points/game), Chris Howell (12.6) and Otto Landrum (12.0).
- 7. Canyon Crest comes into the game averaging 55.3 points per game with two double digit individual scorers. Senior Jon Pearson and junior Miguel Yniguez average 18.7 and 12.0 points a game respectively.
- 8. In a COVID-shortened season, the Falcons are still attempting to play the maximum allotment of games (28). This week, the two matchups against the Ravens are the only games the Falcons will play. This will mark one of only three weeks all season where the Falcons will not play three or more games.
- 9. The games tonight and tomorrow are part of the North County Conference nonleague schedule. This will be the first time that Torrey Pines and Canyon Crest have not been in the same league since the 2011-2012 season. For the 2021 season, the Falcons have moved to the Coastal League while the Ravens are in the Avocado.
