



#1 Torrey Pines Falcons (25-0, 7-0)

vs. La Costa Canyon Mavericks (8-8, 3-4)

9 Facts to Know:

1. Torrey Pines and La Costa Canyon squared off last night at the home of the Falcons. The two teams were tied at 16 after one quarter, but Torrey Pines went on to win 66-48 with four Falcons scoring double digits (Herrmann 20, Landrum 13, Howell 12, Witte 10).
2. Torrey Pines has wrapped up their 9th straight League Championship. This year's Coastal League title was secured after last Saturday's win over Vista. The 2021 win gave Coach Olive his 18th at the helm of the Falcons.
3. After last night's win, the Falcons have now been victorious in 11 straight games over the rival Mavericks. This winning streak in one of San Diego high school sports' most storied rivalries goes back to the 2013-2014 season.
4. Nick Herrmann (#1) recorded his first career double-double last night - on senior night! Herrmann had been either 1 assist or 1 rebound short in two games this season, but he finally broke through with a 20 point, 10 rebound performance yesterday.
5. For the second time in CIF San Diego Open Division history, Torrey Pines has secured the #1 seed for the Open playoffs. The Falcons host the #8 seed and will find out who that is when brackets are released tomorrow.
6. With win #25 last night, Torrey Pines secured its 8th consecutive 25 win season.
7. Last night, the Falcons were 24/31 from inside the three point arc, a season high 77%. For the season, Torrey Pines shoots 57% from 2P. Aman Fikre (67%), Nate Witte (65%), Logan Huston (65%) and Cameron Klein (64%) are all over 60% from two this year.
8. Despite only missing 20 shots last night, the Falcons gathered 9 offensive rebounds off those misses. This was only the 6th time in 25 games this season where Torrey Pines didn't have double-digit offensive rebounds. The Falcons average 11.7 per game led by Otto Landrum's 3.6.
9. Torrey Pines' regular season win streak now stands at 38 games. The Falcons have not lost a non-playoff game since December of 2019.
